

Pageant of Lights Parade Entry Form



Welcome to the 2019 Pageant of Lights

We hope you join with us in celebrating the festive season by entering this year's Parade.

The 2019 Pageant of Lights will take place on Thursday, 5 December 2019, with the annual turning on of the Christmas lights, live entertainment, festive parade and markets. This will all happen in Bourbong Street, between Targo & Maryborough Streets.

Entry is free with a \$350 prize for the winner of each category.

The organisers reserve the right to reject any entry, which, in their opinion, is likely to cause offence or pose a risk to public safety.

- <u>Section C</u> Community/Club Group

PRIZES

Winners of the parade will be presented with certificates in the CBD Pavilion at approximately 8.15pm. Please have a representative present to collect certificate. *Prizes will be distributed within* **7-10 working days after the event.**

JUDGING

Judging will be completed whilst the parade is in progress starting at 7.00pm.

<u>ENTRY INFORMATION (Please retain this page for your information.</u> Complete and return only the Entry Form)

- Entry is free and closes on Friday, 22 November, 2019;
- Entries received after this date, <u>may</u> be able to participate, but will be located at the rear of the parade;
- The Parade shall assemble in Bourbong Street between Tantitha & Walla Streets and Tantitha Street between First Choice Bottle Shop & Woongarra Streets, from 5.30pm; *(Please take note of your allocated arrival time on your confirmation)*
- Final information will be emailed to entrants prior to the event or it will be given to entrants on the night;
- Any floats forming part of an entry need to be in place by their allocated time;
- Floats and/or entries arriving after 6.45pm will be placed at the end of the parade;
- The parade will commence promptly at 7.00pm.
- All entrants need to be mindful of the size, width and height of their float/vehicle to ensure they can safely manoeuvre the entire parade route without hindrance. Failure to comply may result in you not being able to participate.

Please note that food & drinks will be available on the night near coral coast ford for parade entrants



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PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations apply to all Pageant of Lights Parade applicants and participants:

- PARTICIPANTS MUST SUITABLY DISPLAY CHRISTMAS SPIRIT;
- <u>Public Liability Insurance is compulsory for all Parade Entrants. A copy of your current Certificate</u> of Currency must be forwarded with your Registration Entry;
- For safety reasons throwing or handing of items (lollies, brochures etc) or using bubbles from floats or walking participants is <u>NOT</u> permitted under any circumstances (excludes Santa's float). Offenders may be removed from the parade. Bundaberg Regional Council encourages patrons to distribute any items in the Event area prior to or at the completion of the Parade;
- It is advised that only the final float will carry Santa (provided by Bundaberg Regional Council). Santa is <u>not</u> to be displayed by any other participant;
- Bundaberg Regional Council's and the Parade Marshall's decision regarding all entries is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Please obey their instructions at all times;
- Each Entrant will be limited to 2 vehicles (i.e. 2 vehicles or 1 vehicle towing a trailer) participating in the parade;
- Walking Groups are permitted forward manoeuvres <u>ONLY</u>. A spacing of 15 metres between each float/group is required, all floats/groups are required to close the gap between participants when asked by parade officials and to please be aware of the gap behind you;
- The safe maximum height for floats/entrants is 3 meters due to low lying branches in the parade route. Please do not exceed this height as it may cause a safety issue;
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly forbidden on any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any participant;
- It is Council's preference that all vehicles turn at the turning circle just prior to the intersection of Bourbong Street & Maryborough Street;
- Bundaberg Regional Council has adopted a local law prohibiting the release of helium balloons. As the gateway to the Southern Great Barrier Reef, Council is committed to protecting the environment and particularly our world renowned local Mon Repos Turtle Rookery. In an effort to minimise accidental release which could impact our local marine life and in order to set a positive example for the community, helium balloons will be banned at all Council run events;
- It is the responsibility of those with animals as a part of their entry to ensure that they are under their control and no mess is left behind them.
